



The Waypoint Program is a residential treatment program for adolescent males with sexually aggressive behaviors, ages 12-17. The program emphasizes comprehensive diagnostic assessments, evaluation, and multidisciplinary treatment planning which focuses on an individualized treatment phased system. We provide the expertise to address sexual aggression, behavioral and affective disorders, as well as continued educational services through a fully accredited on-site school.

Therapeutic Treatment

The treatment team works to identify existing pathology and develops treatment interventions/plans based on the unique problems of the individual while ensuring that individual strengths are utilized to ensure successful outcomes.
